In the recent judgement, Acting Chief Justice of Delhi High Court, Rajiv Sahai Endlaw, J has ordered that:

"all the recognized aided and unaided private schools in Delhi to appoint Special Educators and to make their buildings/school premises barrier free so as to provide free movement/access to children with disabilities. We further direct the DoE, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, to ensure compliance of the directions issued by this Court and to take action for de-recognition against the erring schools. We, however, grant time upto 31st March, 2013, to the said schools to, if not have already done, make their school premises barrier free/access free."

They have further ordered that:

"no school shall refuse admission to children with disability for the reason of not employing Special Educators or not providing barrier free access in the school premises".
